- We provide weekly classes that focus on the three main subjects of theatre – acting, singing, and dance.
- A combination of fun games and stimulating exercises develop technique, style, and method - the students learn without even realizing it!

Classes

By tailoring our classes to each individual's needs we create a supportive environment in which our students can feel comfortable and confident to explore their creative potential.

Warm Up: A group warm up involving students of all ages, encourages students to work together, support each other and help each other out.

Acting: Drama games and technique exercises aim to develop self-confidence and performance skills. We encourage individual expression and focus on developing the use of each student's own thoughts and feelings in their work. A variety of script work, improvisation and character-building games are an integral part of this class, also looking at accent work and audition preparation.

Singing: Students are introduced to a wide range of musical styles and vocal skills and have the opportunity to perform solo as well as with the rest of the company.

Dance: From contemporary to musical theatre, our dance lessons cover a diverse range of styles. Students learn how to use and shape their bodies, as well as strengthen posture and improve coordination.

Performances



Summer Show: Students take part in a full-scale Musical Theatre production each year which is performed at theatres in both Carlisle and Penrith. This is a chance for students to showcase the skills they have learned in class and also opens up technical theatre opportunities for anyone who may wish to get involved backstage to have a go!

Christmas ACTstravaganza: Students are given the chance to devise scenes and add their own choreography to the dance pieces for the Christmas show giving them freedom to explore their creative potential.

These productions allow students to experience performing in 3 different theatres, gaining knowledge and understanding of how a show is put together.

We also like to get our students out and about, performing in the local area and at events such as the Penrith Winter Droving and Carlisle Collective Fringe Festival.
